As of **March 1st 2010** the Government of Mexico requires new documentation to enter Mexico under a "tourist status".

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Canadian Citizens who enter Mexico by air, land or sea do not require visa. However a **valid passport** must be presented at the port of entry to prove their nationality. (A validity of a minimum of 6 months is recommended).
2. Permanent Residents of Canada, regardless of nationality must present one of the following valid documents:
 - a) Permanent Residency Card, or
 - b) Certificate of Identity, or
 - c) Refugee Travel Document
 - A valid Passport is no longer required for Permanent Residents to enter Mexico. However, a passport may be required to re-enter Canada.
